

Bogotá

Bogotá is on the move. Once considered a place to avoid, the capital has leaned up its act and is fast becoming one of Latin America's urban highlights. Improved security, infrastructure projects and a clean-up campaign have helped bring a new face to the metropolis. You can find that the streets are not exactly paved with gold and end up eking Graceful churches, excellent museums, cultural events and a thriving nightlife can keep you busy for several days. Bogotá is also the political, financial and service center for the country, and its geographic heart, making it a useful base from which to explore the country. Finally we will take a cable card to the top of Monserrate that lords over Bogota where we will admire a wonderful view of the city. 3	Bogotá	<p>Breakfast at your hotel.</p> <p><i>During</i> the morning we will leave the city thorough the residential district, taking the Panamericana highway, passing by some typical villages to reach to Zipaquirá where the Salt Cathedral is located, visit and returned to Bogota. (Duration of this tour 4 hours.)</p> <p>A huge underground cathedral. This magic and spiritual place will be unforgettable for you and your close ones. During the tour you will be able to see important landmarks such as Puente del Común and the spectacular sightseeing of Bogota from the mountains of La Calera, where you will take beautiful pictures of the urban landscape. We will have a delicious snack break, since the Bogota Sabana is the perfect place to taste the famous pandeyucas and almojabanas accompanied by a terrific Chocolate Santafereno</p> <p>Rest of the day at leisure.</p> <p>Lodging.</p>
